Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) Program

The Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) Program is accepting applications for Low-to-Moderate income households in need of repairs. The CHIP Program covers all Wayne County. To qualify, the overall household income must be under a set annual income amount, which is determined by the number of persons in the household. For instance, a family of four **gross** income limit is \$54,200 (moderate income limit). Unfortunately, no property within the 100 year floodplain is eligible for the CHIP Program.
